

2023 Annual ISPA Report

Financial

Total ISPA Assets as of December 31, 2023: \$101,262.91, which was up \$19,088.91 from 2022.

2023 Income = \$45,962.82, which was up from \$18,002 in 2022

2023 Expenses = \$32,284.87, which was down from \$78,345 in 2022

Notes:

- Income for the society was up in 2023 primarily as a result of generous sponsorships for the upcoming ICPA.
- The Board conducted an annual financial review for the 2023 financials and found that the society's financials were in good order.
- ISPA annual membership fees for 2023 were \$80 with 50% discount for countries with low-income and middle-low-income economies as defined by the World Bank Organization.

Membership

- Members as of December 31, 2023: 326 (286 individual memberships, 40 student memberships)
- Members as of December 31, 2022: 374 (339 individual memberships, 35 student memberships)
- Country Representatives as of December 31, 2023: 44 (covering 36 countries; 10 new countries that did not have representatives before)
- Country Representatives as of December 31, 2022: 34 (covering 27 countries)
